- 9. Pray the Fatima Prayer

10. Say the second mystery; then pray the Lord's Prayer. (Repeat 7, 8 and 9 and continue with the third, fourth, and fifth mysteries of the day in the same manner.)

11. Pray the Hail, Holy Queen.
